The Park is located at 10 Electric Avenue Dover, Delaware. The 2026 event will commence at 8:30 a.m. while the Opening Ceremony is scheduled for 9:00 a.m. and Closing TAPS at 2:00 p.m.

The history of the Veteran Stand Downs held across this Country today, started with three Vietnam Veterans feeling the need for helping other Veterans. The three Veterans located in San Diego began to identify resources to assist with everyday needs. For the past eighteen years the Veterans' Awareness Center Foundation has been committed to finding the resources needed to help our Veterans resolve issues. Whether the issue is housing, food, medical care, child support, mental health or dental services, Service Providers have been a great source of support.

Over the years, Veterans have looked forward to the Stand Down event where they may locate the services that they need. During the 2025 Stand Down event over 1500 Veterans and Guests registered. Several veterans registered as "homeless" or "at risk" and were taken care of during the Stand Down event! In addition to the services, our Delaware Veterans were excited for the warm luncheon served. The Stand Down event is organized, planned, and carried out by a 100% Volunteer Committee. The Stand Down is a rollup-your-sleeves-and-serve volunteer event to help those who served our Country.

This September 2026, we are expecting a large group of veterans to attend the Stand Down event, and we simply cannot do it without financial support and in-kind contributions from our community. We are currently seeking contributions to offset the event costs; including the warm meal served for lunch.
